This includes planting and maintenance of new woodlands, scrub clearance, felling, tree surgery, hedgelaying and planting, weed control, stump grinding and mulching, we also use high capacity chippers and timber harvesters to provide a comprehensive all round service to woodland management.



Conservation Contracts can carry out after care and maintenance at an early stage, shortly after new woodland has been planted. It's vital to the survival of newly planted trees. In the past many planting projects have failed due to the lack of after care in the years immediately after planting. The first three years are vitally important, if aftercare is lacking young trees will be stunted for a few years, putting on very little new growth, or dying back. Unweeded young trees in long grass will be lost from view, within a season and may die. Newly planted trees require a weed-free area of at least one metre diameter around stem.
